This first section will explain all the terms, buttons, concepts... all the stuff you need to get started. Later, we'll talk about creating your own banners, with professional looking graphics!

Here we have the member's area:



We can go through the tabs... our Menu.

Home – brings you to this page.. your main member's area. It lists the 3 steps you need, in order to use Instant Banner creator successfully.

Logout – This is where you... um... Log out.

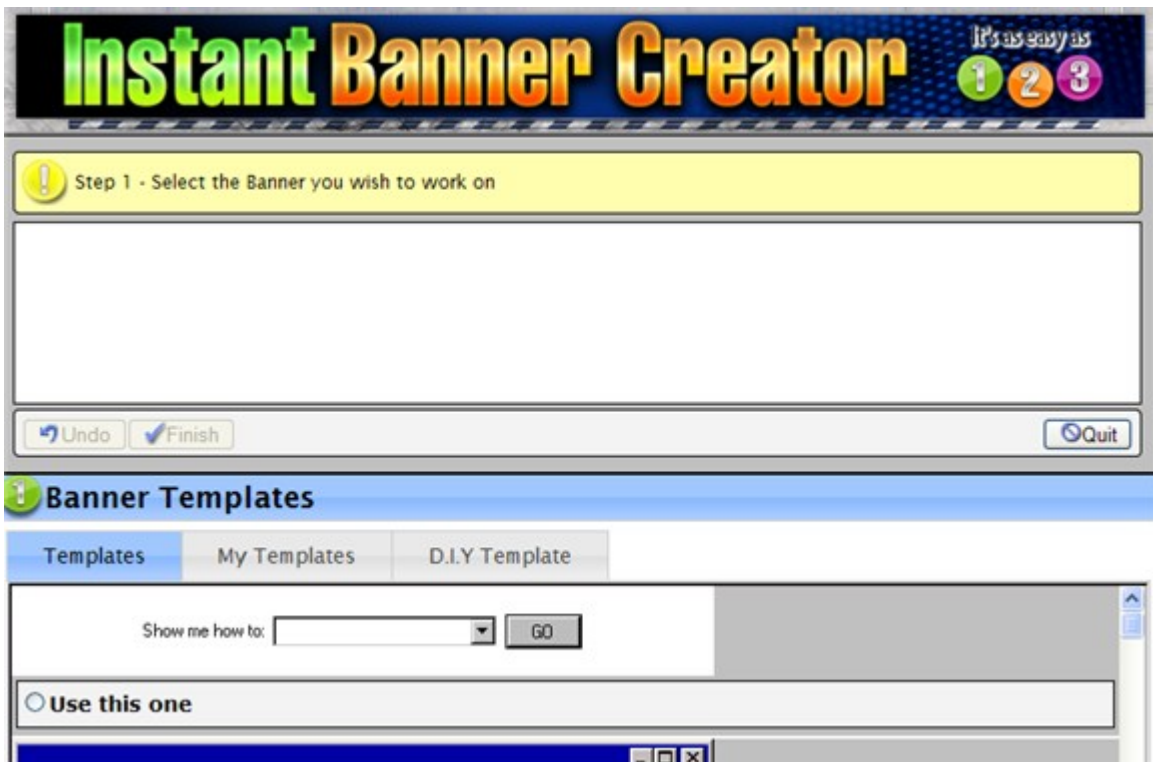
Create New Graphics!

Yay! Now we get to create our first graphic!

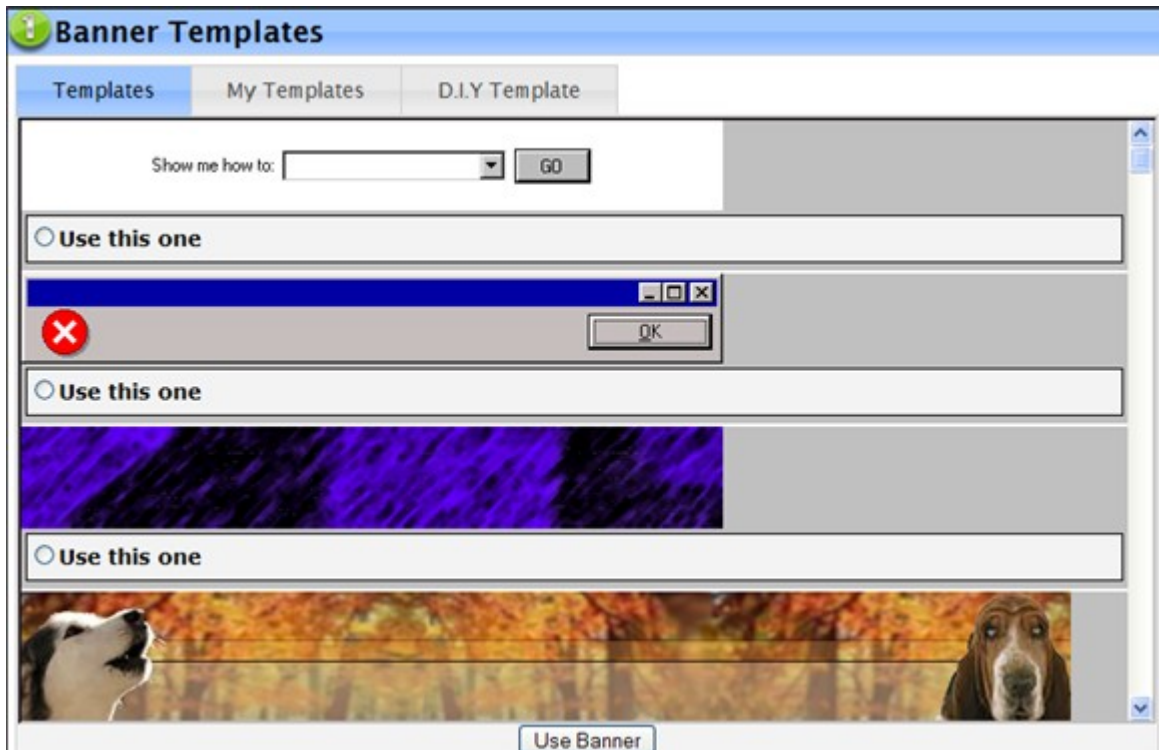
Click the "Create New Graphics" button.



First we'll create an new banner. After you click on "Create New Banner"... you'll see this.

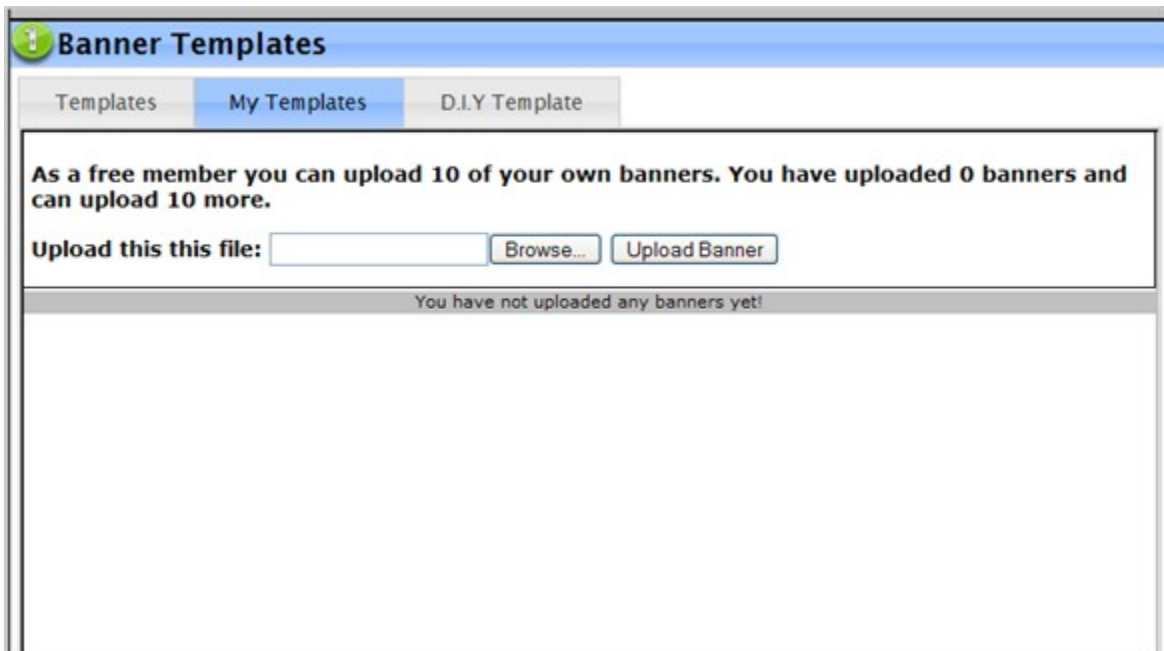


Here, when you scroll down, you'll see LOTS of banner templates to choose from.



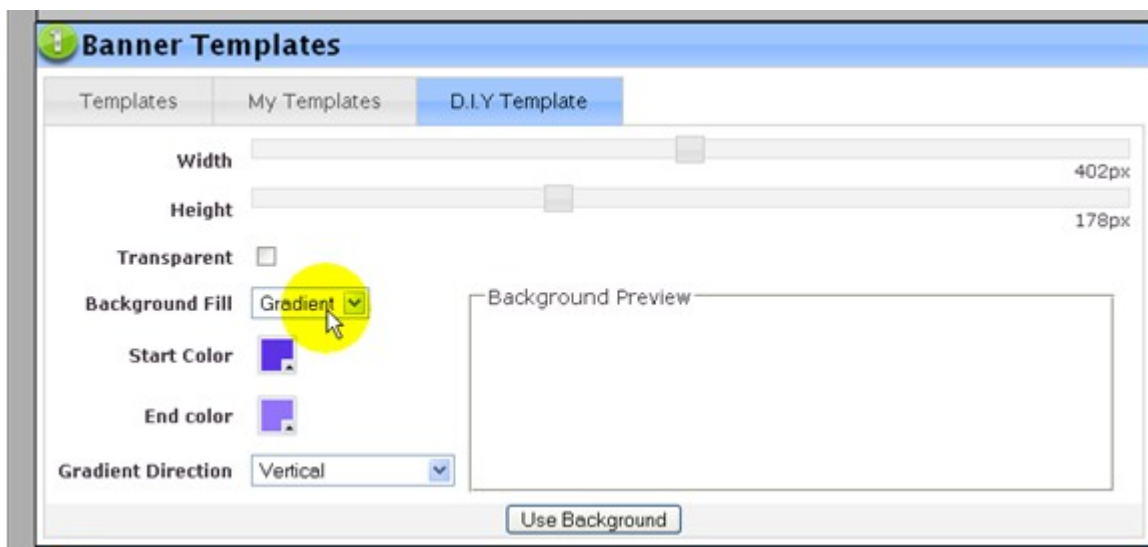
Here are just a few. You also have the choice of using your own template... you can make those yourself, or sometimes get them in PLR packages.

Here in the "My Templates" tab...



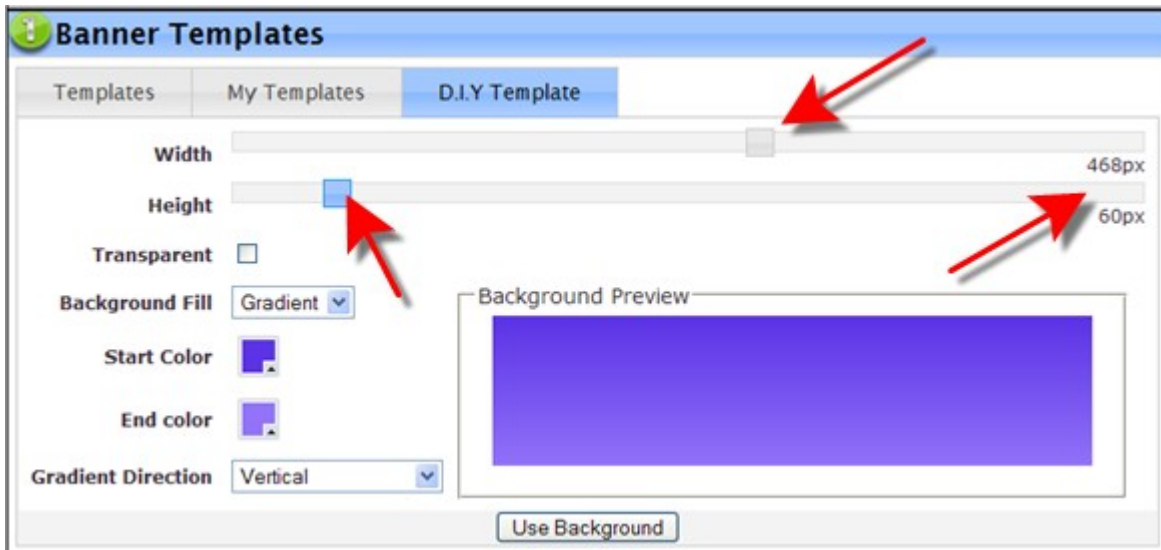
you can upload the template right from your computer, by finding the file with the browse button, then click "Upload Banner" to save the template in your banner area.

You can also create your own template... by clicking the D.I.Y. Template tab.



You can choose the size, transparency, background... everything you need is here.

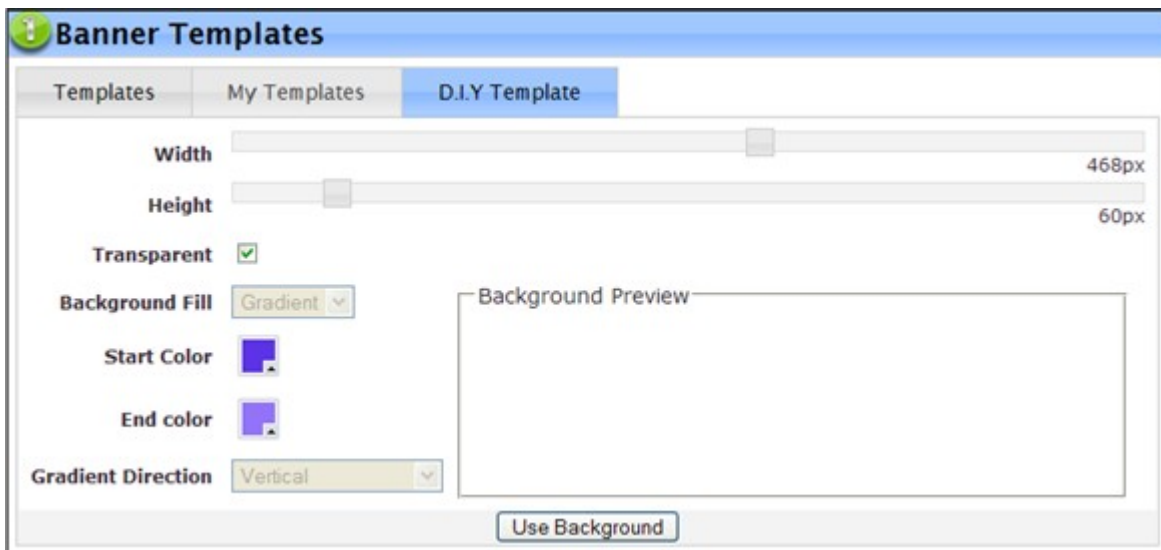
So, let's do that. First let's choose the size... most banners are 468x60.



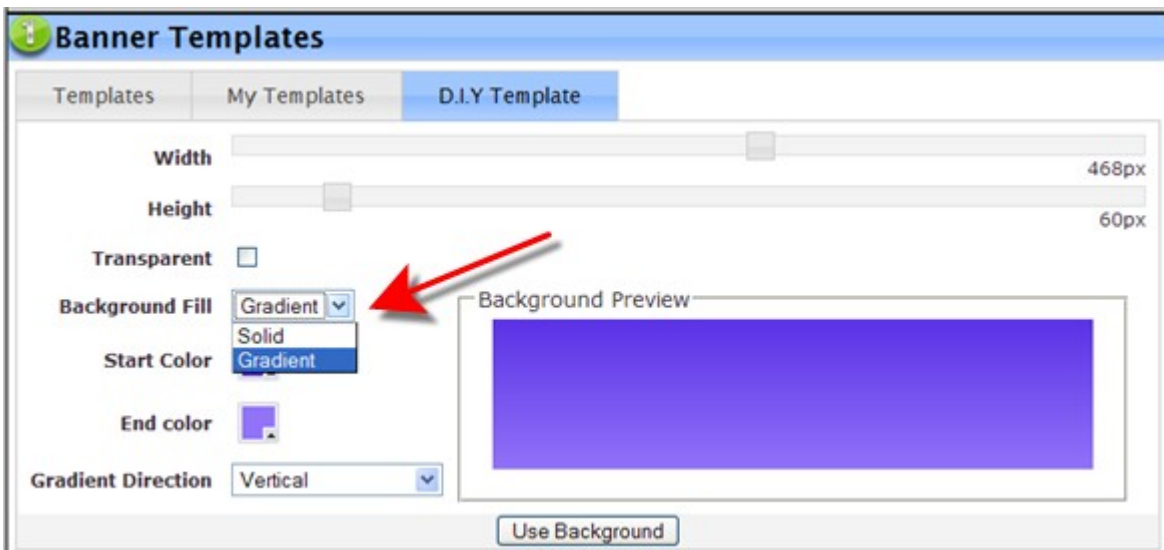
As you move the Width Slider... you'll see the numbers change on the right. Move the width slider until it shows "468px"

Then do the same with the Height Slider... until it shows "60px".

By checking the "Transparent" box... you'll have no color in the banner, and it will be ready for the next step. But.. we won't do that.

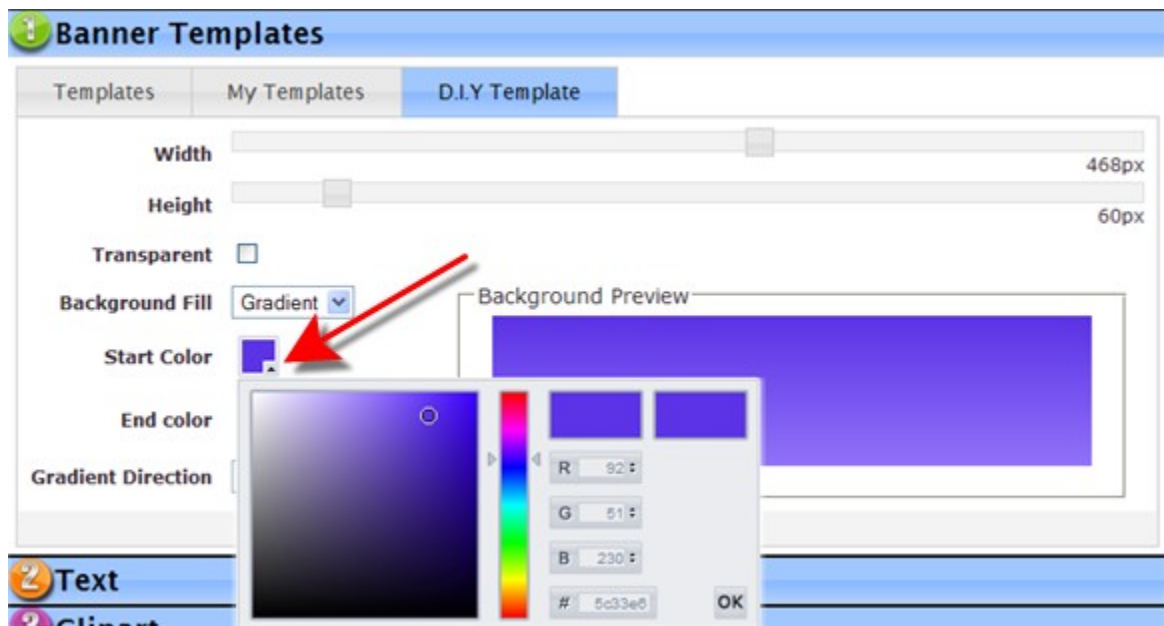


In the Background Fill dropdown, you have a choice of either gradient or solid.

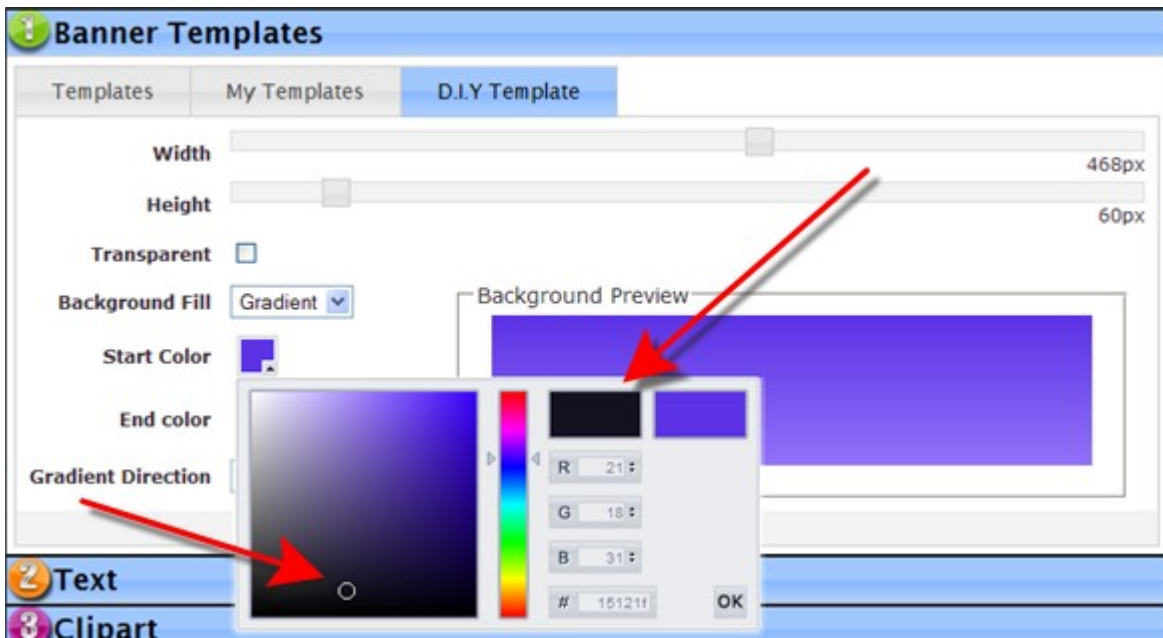


When you choose gradient... pick a start and end color.

Choose a color, by clicking on the color box.

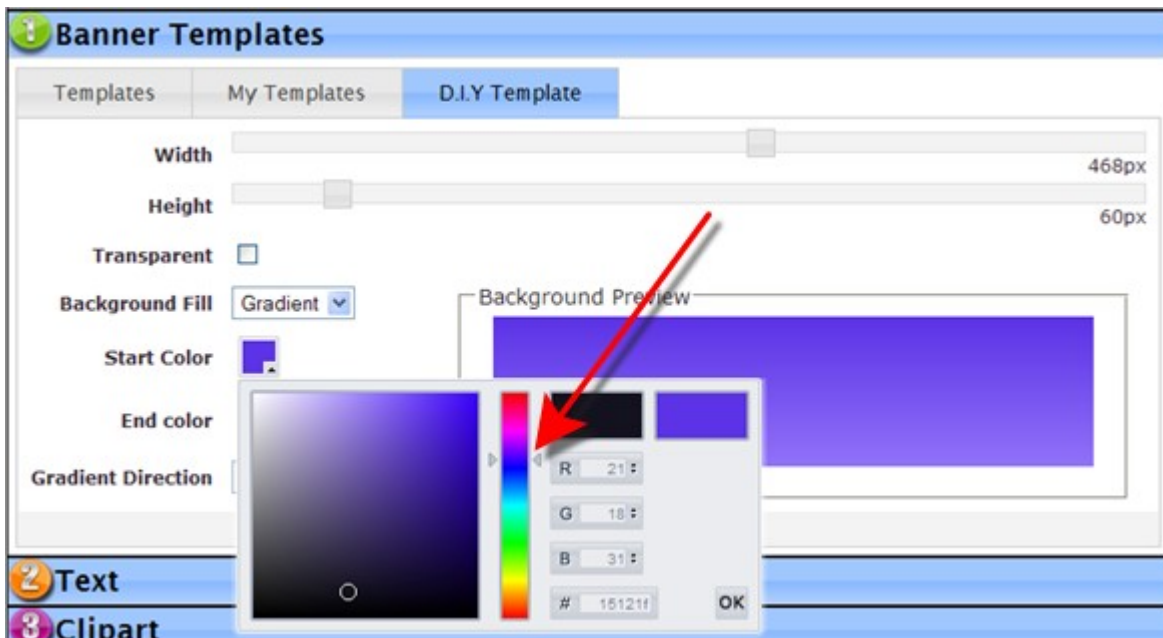


Place your cursor on the little circle there... right click and drag the circle to the color you want.

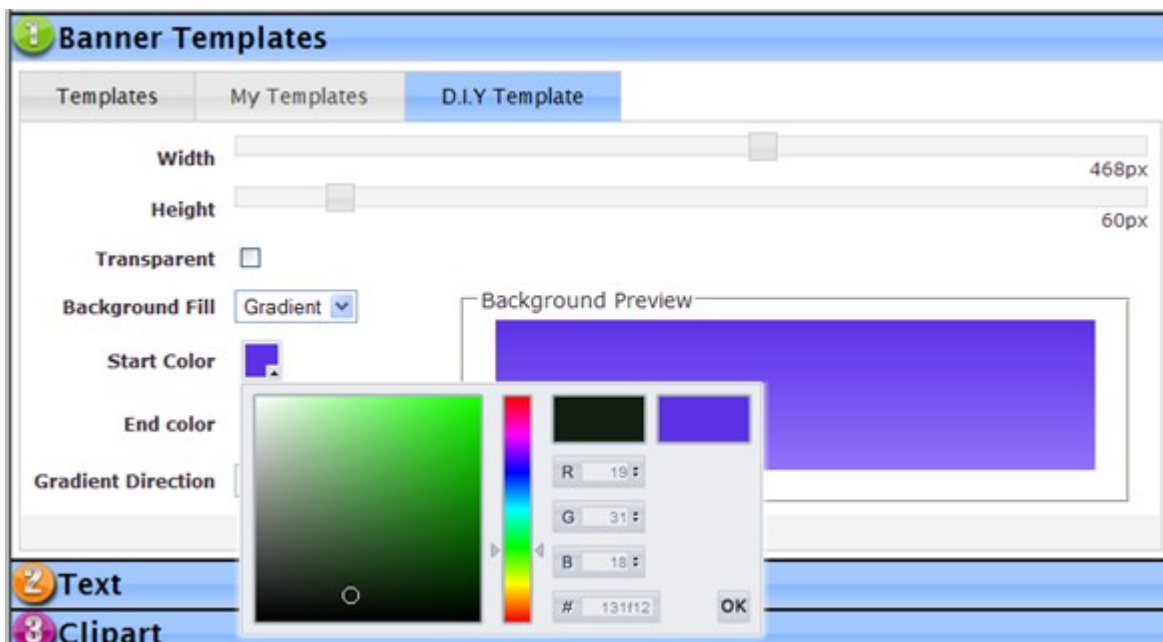


You see the 2 little colored squares there, by the 2nd arrow? The left one is your new color, and the right one is your original color. When you have the color you want, click the OK button.

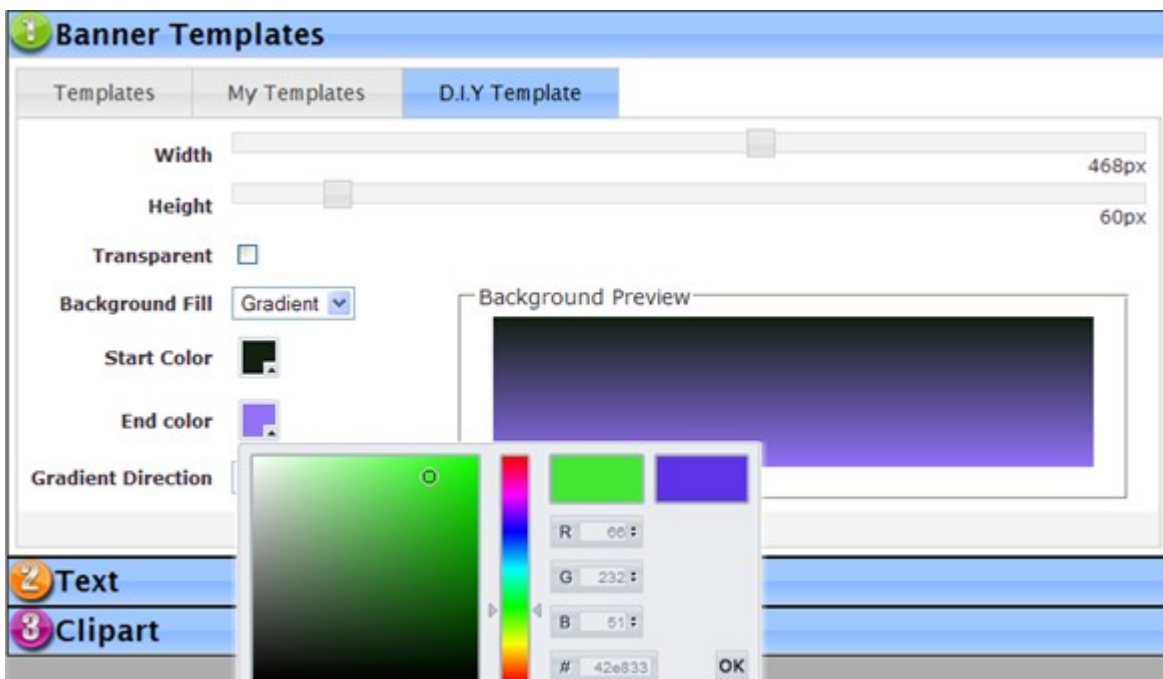
You can have another color besides blue, too... right click on the little arrows pointing at the rainbow...



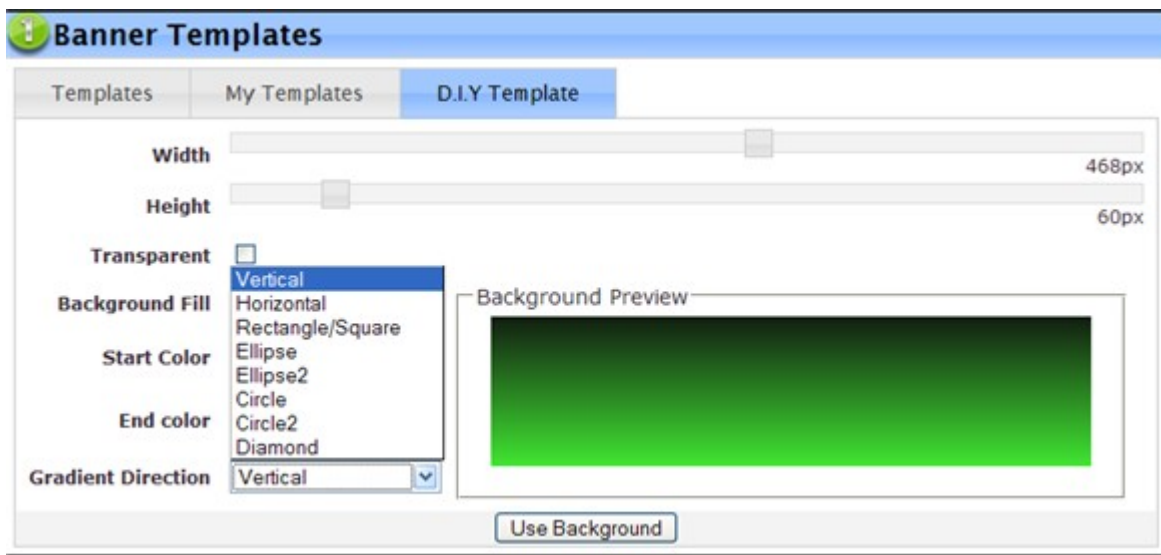
and drag it up and down to change the colors.



So.. let's go with this almost black color.



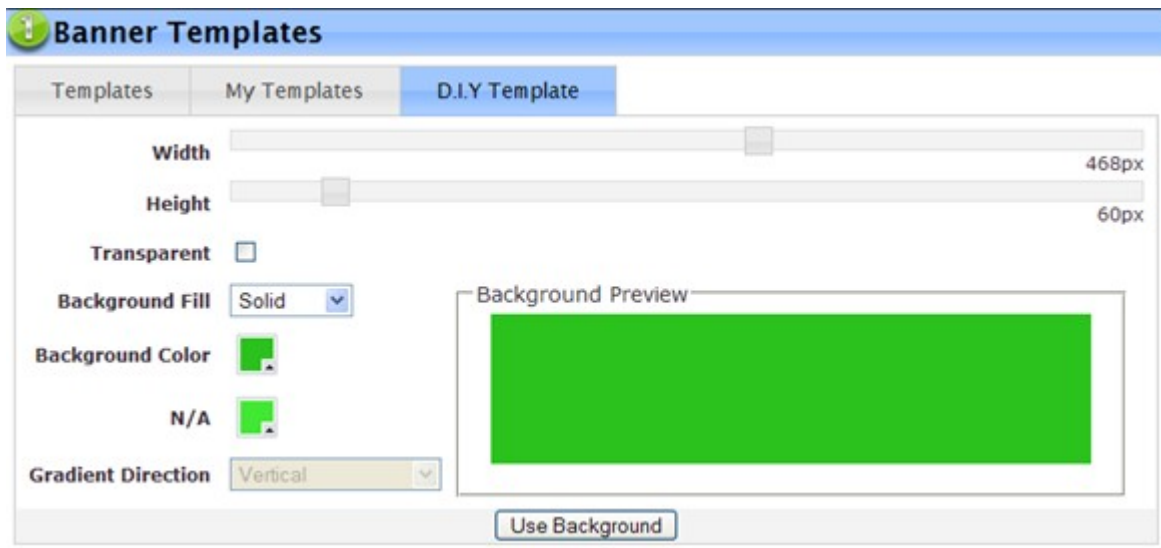
Then click the color box for "End color"... and do the same thing. I'll pick green this time.



Then you can choose the Gradient Direction with this dropdown box.

I suggest playing with this a while.. to see what you like best. The possibilities are endless!

Now we'll see what a Solid background fill will look like... in green.



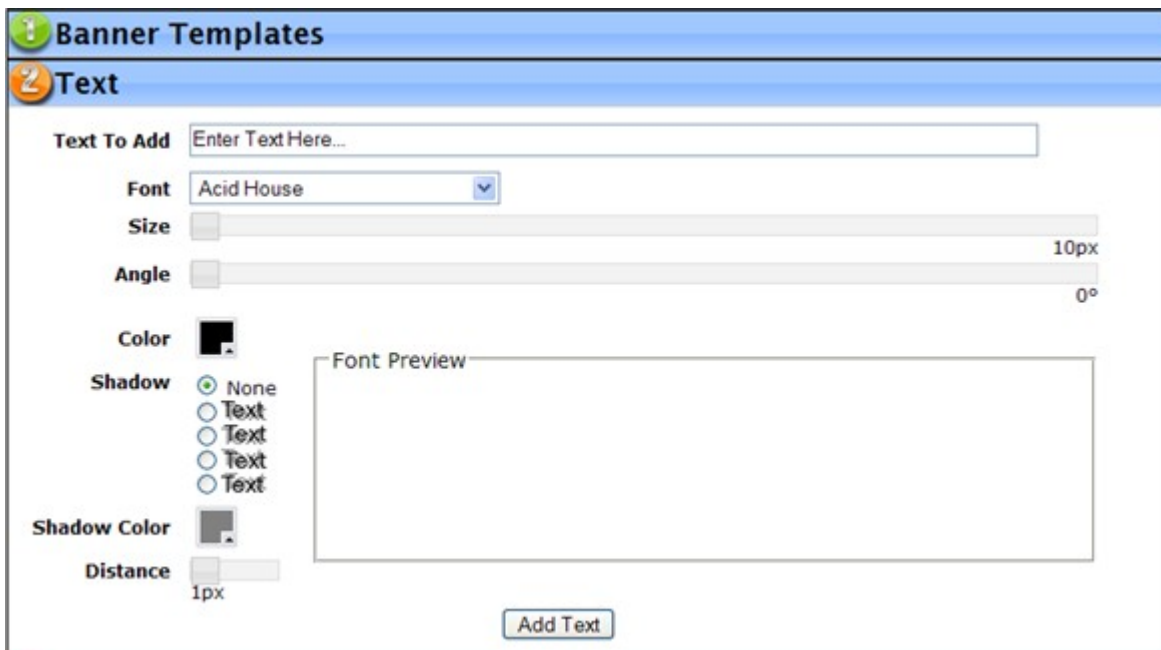
I changed the background color to green, then what would be the "end color" is now marked "N/A"... since we don't need it.

Click on Use Background, and we're ready to go!

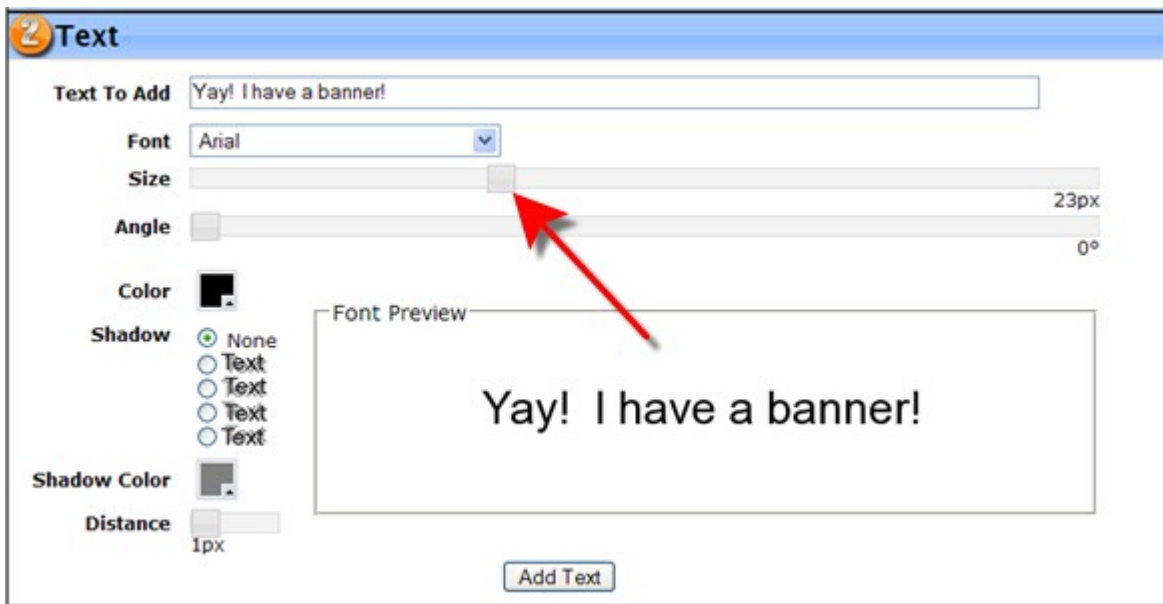


This is what you'll see, the background you made!

Further down on the page, you'll see this.

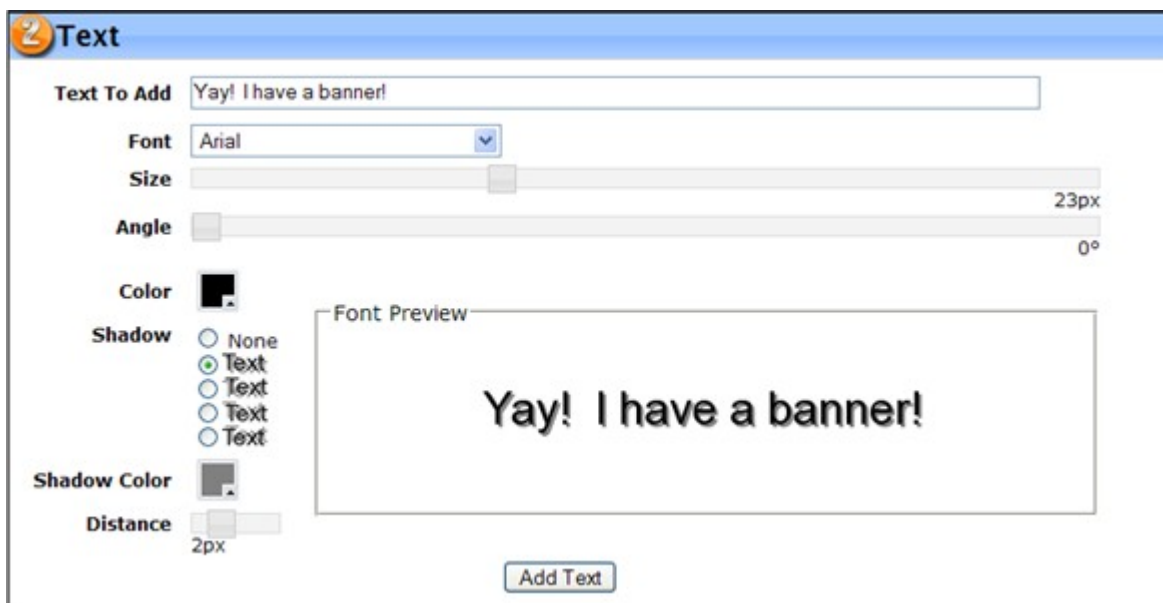


So here, let's enter some text... choose and choose the font. If it doesn't show up in the "Font Preview" window right away, just click on it, and it will.



You can also see that I changed the font size... to make it bigger.

You can change the color, and make a shadow. You can also choose the color of the shadow, and how far you want it from the text.



Then click the "Add Text" button!

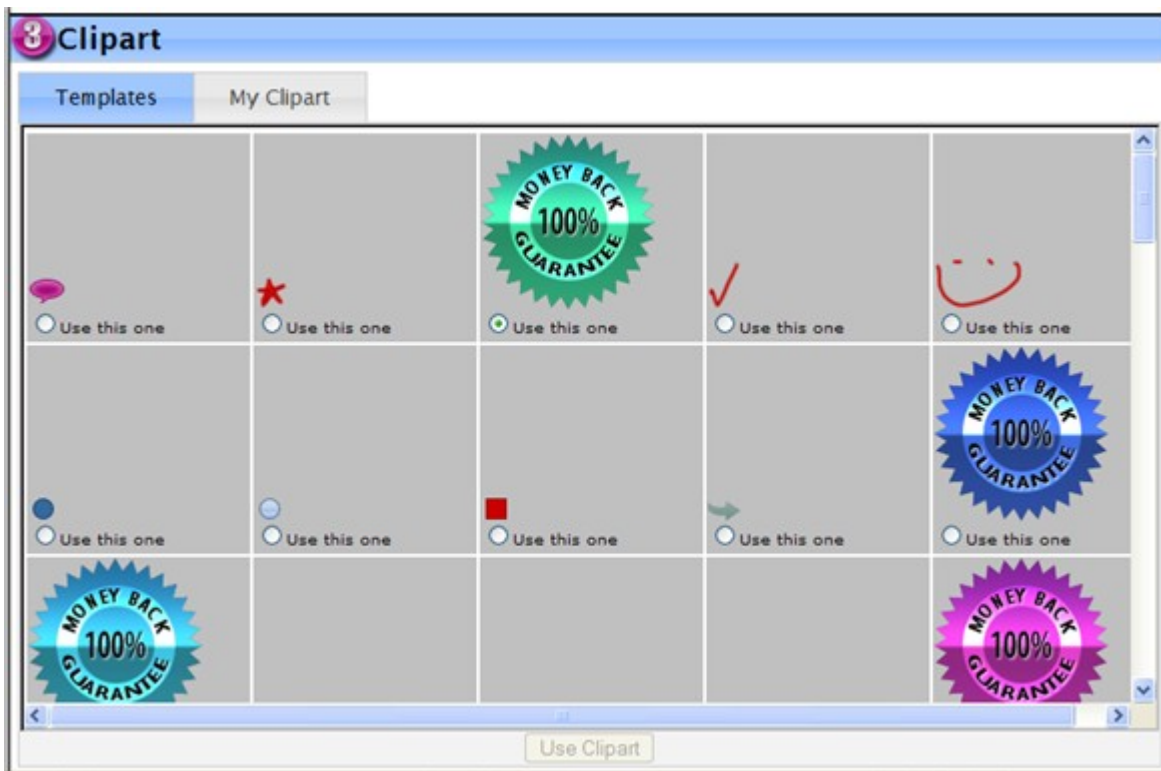
This is what you'll see next. You can right click, and drag your text to any position on the banner. When you're happy with it, click the "Click Here" button. If you decide you want different text... click the "Cancel" button.



If you place the text somewhere, then decide you don't like it, you can click the "Undo" button.



Next, you can add more text, or go to the next section.



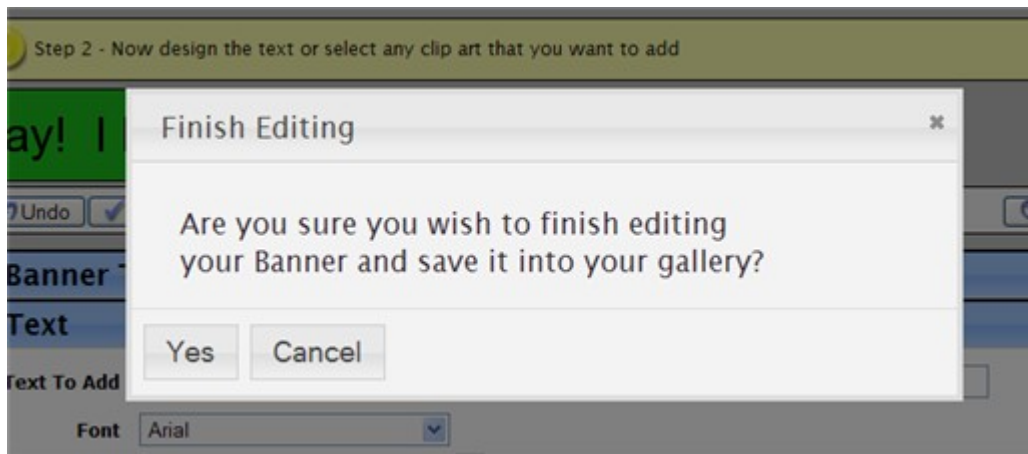
Here you have 2 options... you can use the clipart already on the site, or you can click the "My clipart" tab... and upload images of your own! This is great for branding... if you have a picture of yourself, or a logo... you can store it here.

So... we'll choose the smiley face today, since we're so happy that we made our own banner! Click the little radio button under the picture, and click "Use Clipart".



Again... you'll need to move the picture to the place you want... and press "Click Here" to keep it.

When you have everything done to your banner... you can click the Finish button. You'll see a warning... that looks like this:



Are we sure? Of course we are.... our banner is beautiful! Click "Yes".

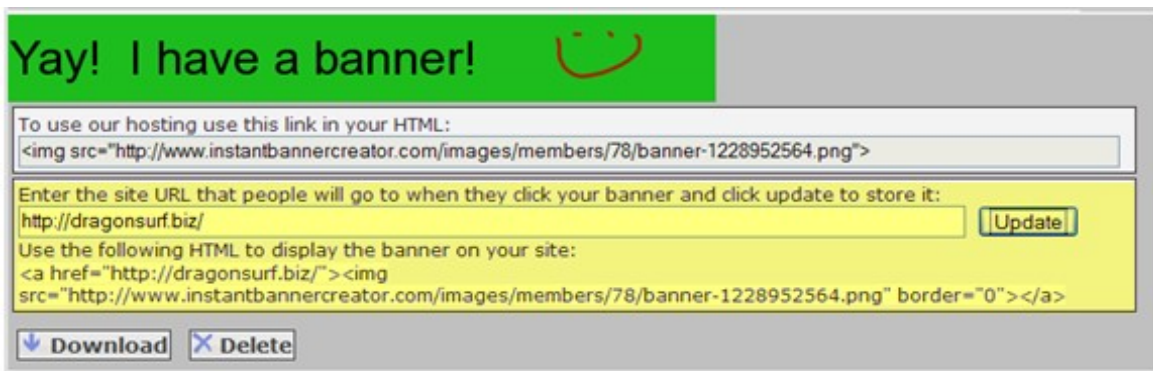


Yay! (Yeah, I say that a lot) Our banner is now stored.

Here's where it gets good.

Instant Banner Creator will host your banners! It gives you the exact URL for the image. But... to use the banner properly... you'll want to let them know what site the user should go to, when they click your banner.

Enter that url in the box provided, and then click "Update".



We can put the URL <http://dragonsurf.biz> in this box.. Below the box where I entered it, is the html code... all ready for us to use on our website! This is so easy!

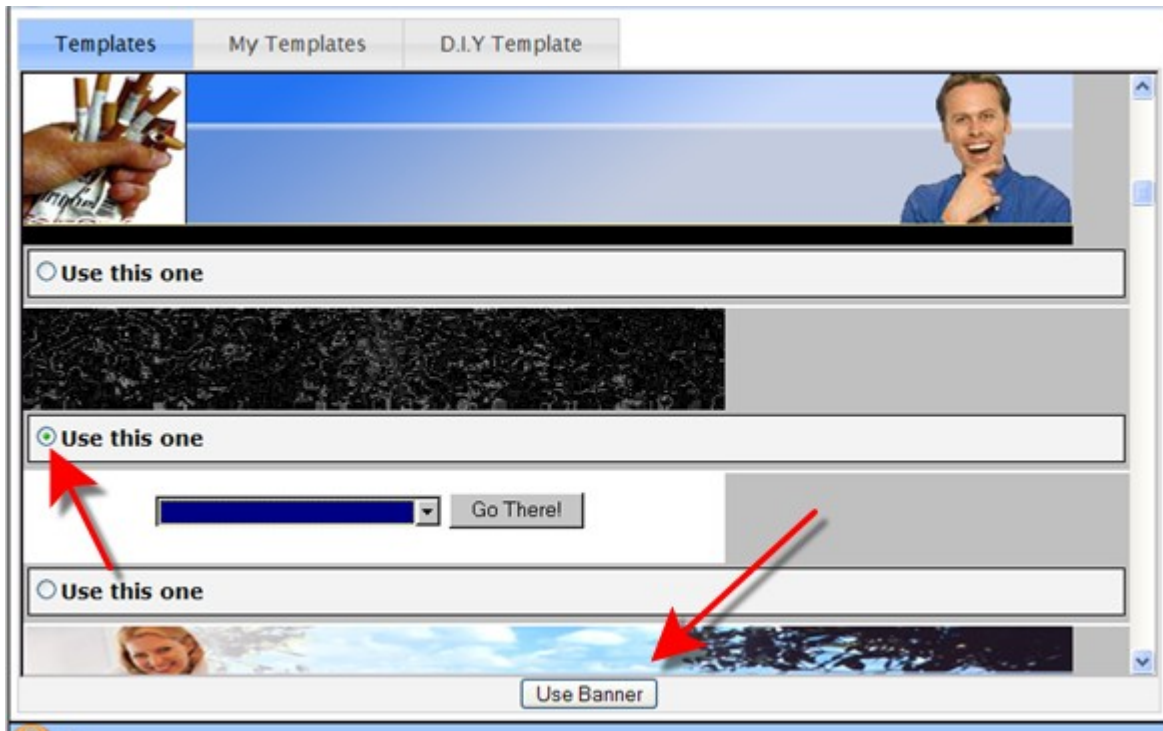
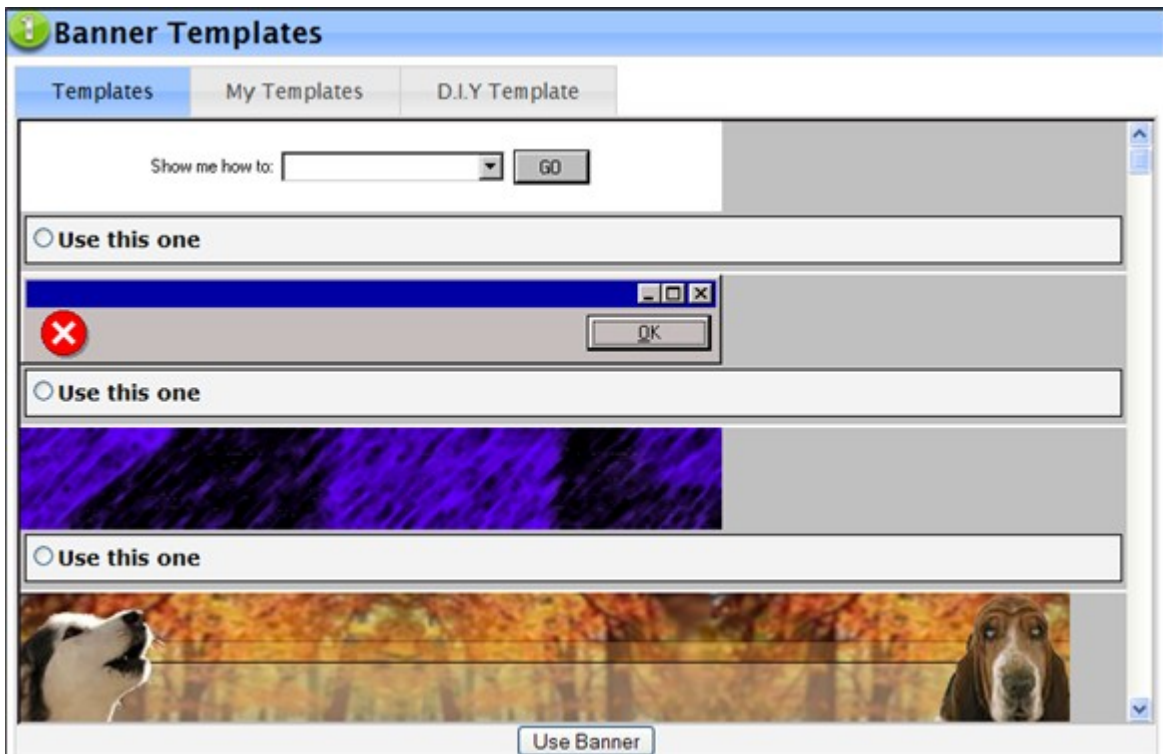
You can also download the image, by clicking the "Download" button, or delete the banner altogether.

Create a New Banner -

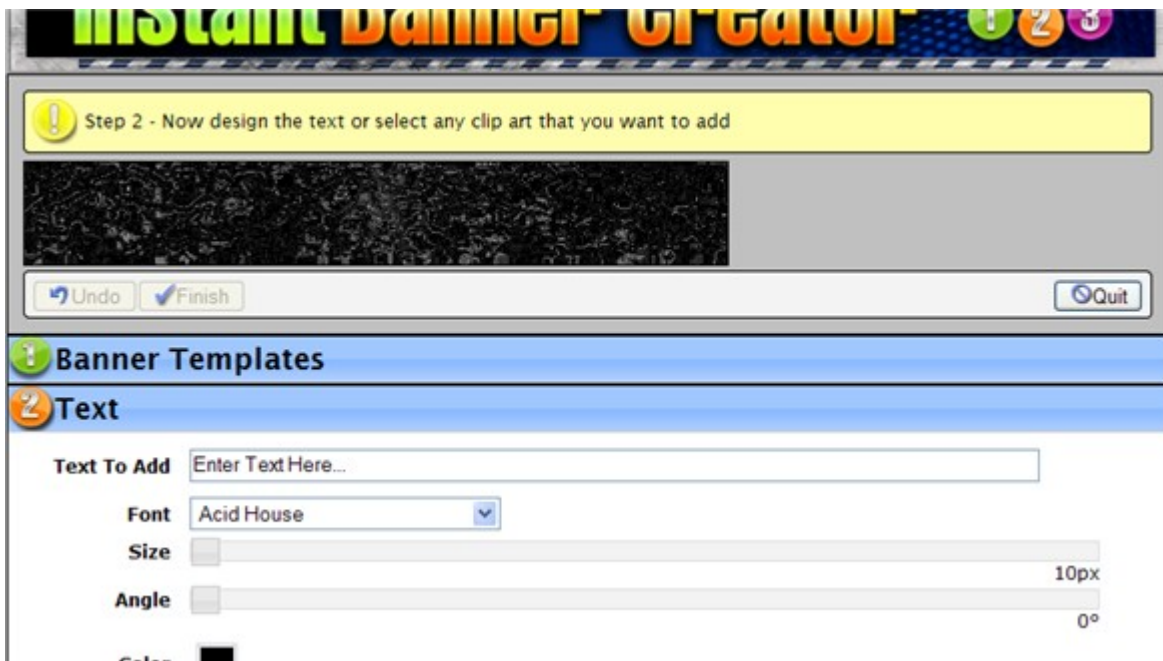
Let's create a banner from the templates inside Instant Banner Creator.



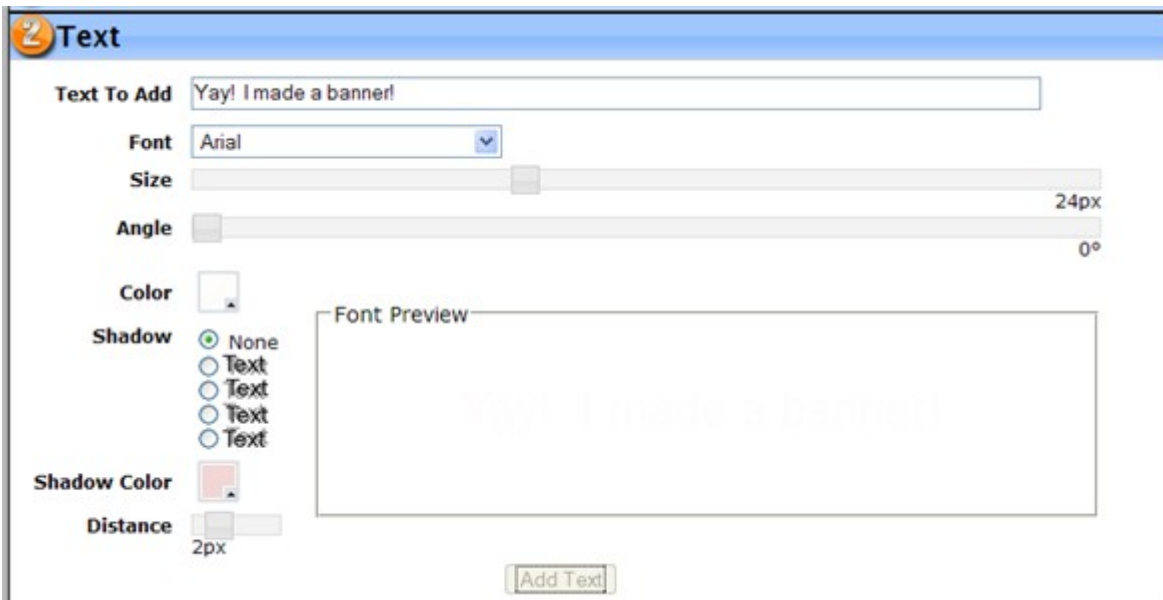
This time... you'll choose a template that's already listed.



Click the button of the one you want, then press "Use Banner".



Next, we can add our text.. just like we did earlier.



Lol.. and I made the text white... to show up on the black banner... like this:



Now we can add an image to it...



Which is my nice little red box... then I press "Click Here" to put it in place.



Then, I added 3 more little red boxes. I like it!

Then press "finish" for the finished product.

Now we're taken back to "Your Saved Graphics".. and you can see both our banners here!

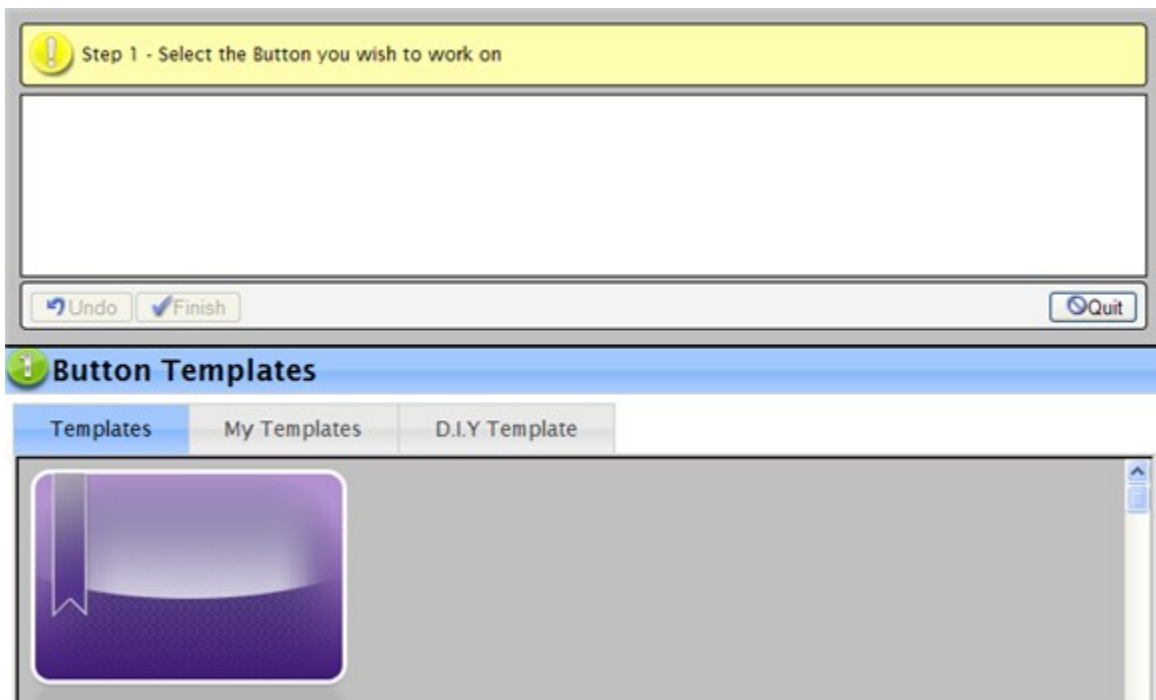
Remember, Instant Banner Creator will host your banners. Type in the URL you want the user to see when they click your banner... and then click "Update". The HTML for the banner will appear, and you can use it on your website!

You can even download the image, by clicking the download button, or delete it with the Delete button.

Create a New Button -



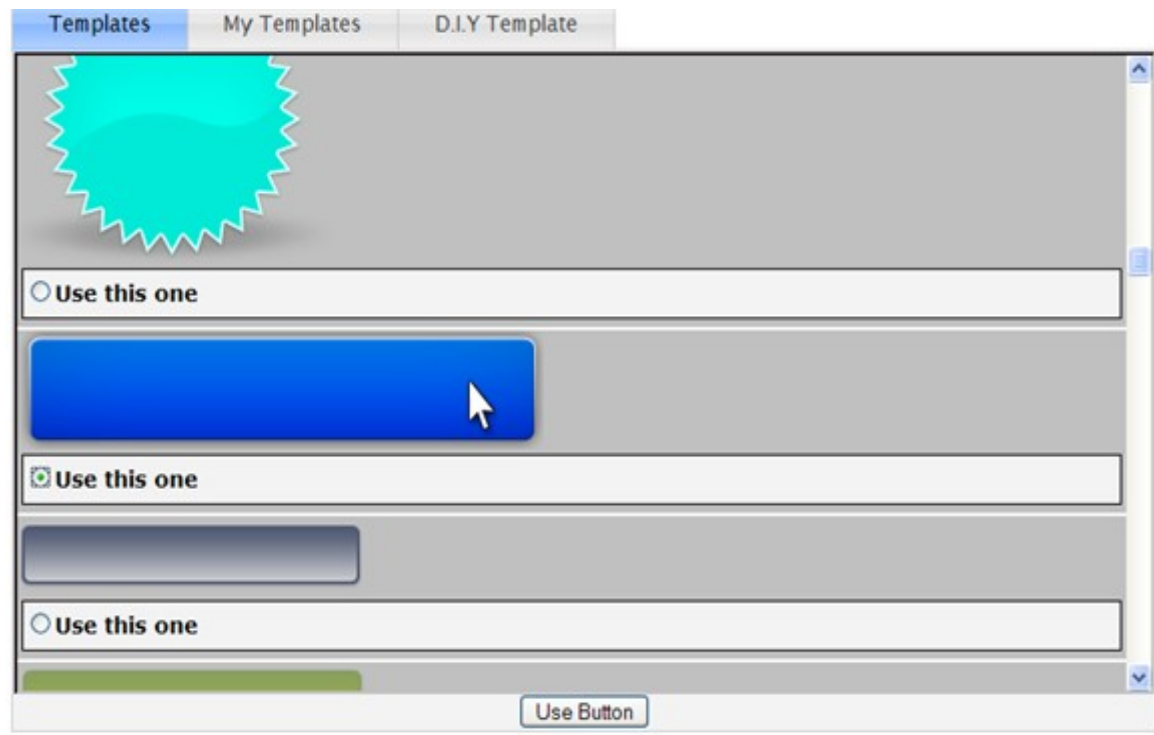
When we click on "Create New Graphics" we'll see this page, and we want to click on "Create A New Button"



You can see that it looks very much like creating your own banner. It works just

the same, too.

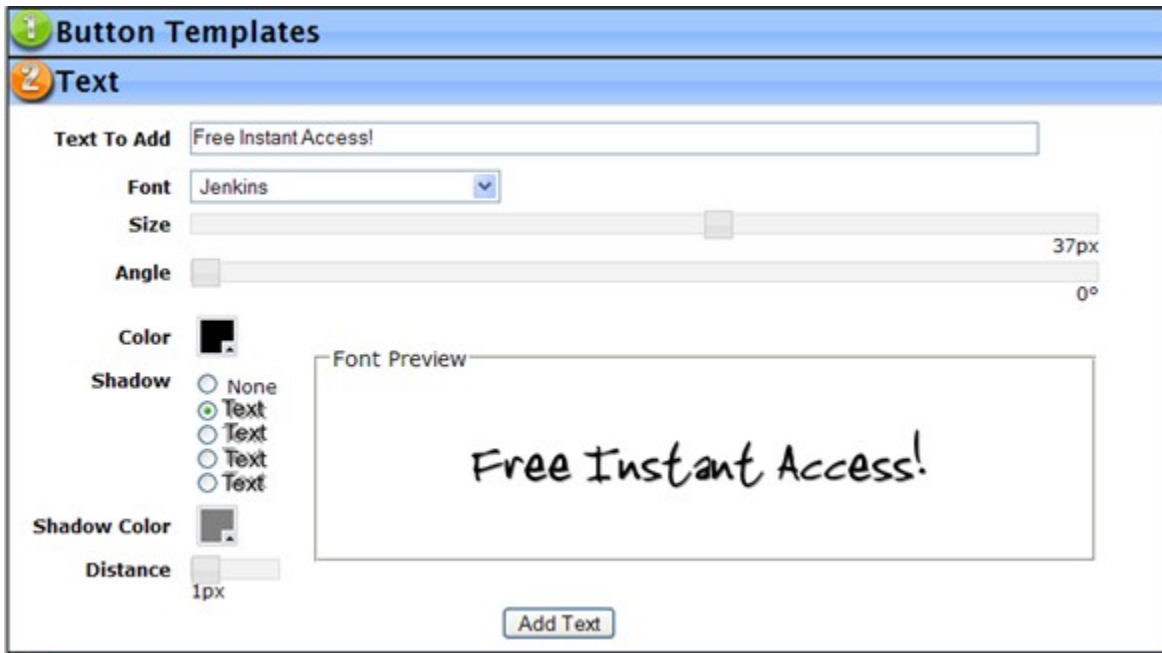
First, let's choose our button.



This time we'll use that blue bar.. click on the "Use this one" button.. and then "Use Button" at the bottom of the section.



Now we can add our Text...



Click the "Add Text" Button, then drag your text to the place you want.

Then click the "Click Here" button to paint it onto the button.



If you want to add clipart you can... but I think we'll just leave this one as is.



So, click the "Finish" button, and here you go!



Once you add the target URL, and click update, you can copy the code to use on your website, or click "Download" to download the image!

You'll see that this button is saved in the "Buttons" tab... separate from your banners.

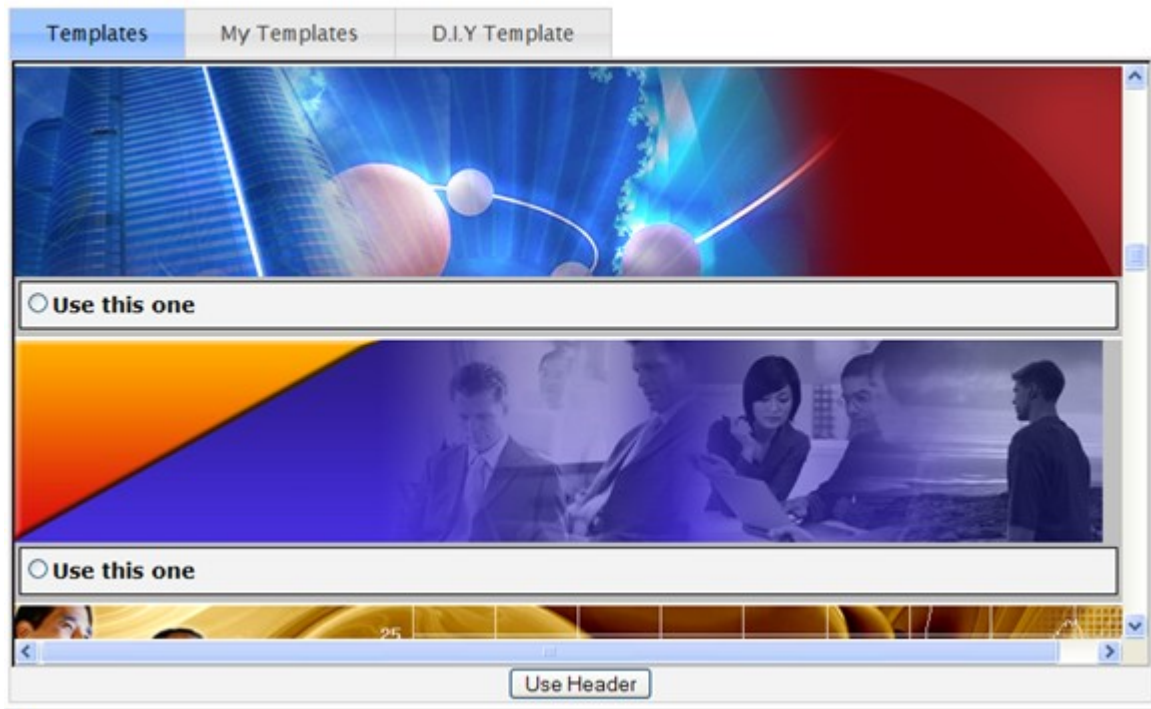
Create a New Header!

If you've read this from the beginning... you'll see that all of these modules are made exactly the same way...

Here we'll create a header for a website.

What Would You Like To Create Today?

You can either use our templates, or upload your own, or design your own. We'll use one provided for us in this example.

This one looks pretty cool....



Next we add the text, and clipart...



This.. ends up like this, on the template:



And.. just like the banners and buttons, Instant Banner Creator will host your headers and footers, too!

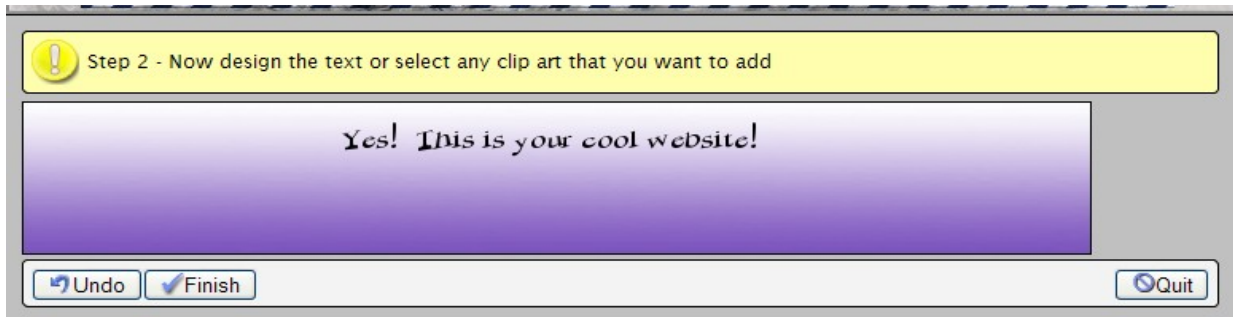
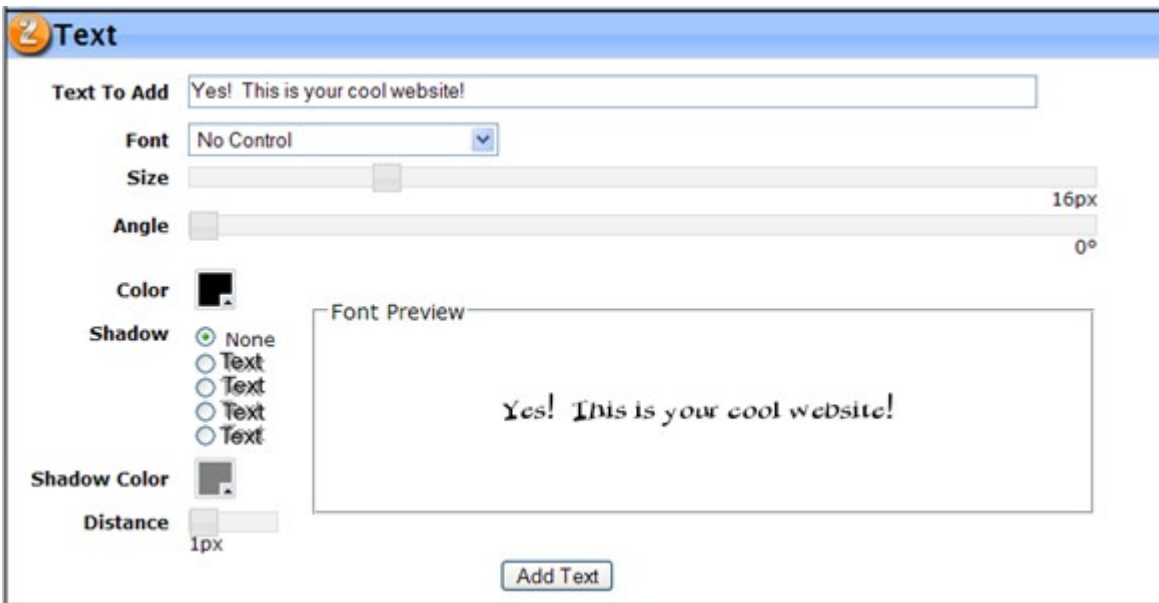
Just copy the URL and place it on your website... or download the image!

Footers!

We'll be able to find a footer template that matches our Header...



And... add some text....



and click "Finish" and your Footer is saved in your Saved Graphics area.



Peel-away Ads -

Now we'll get into peel-away ads... you actually need to create both the small and large. The small one is the ad you see in the top corner of the page, that entices you to click on the ad. The large one is what shows once the mouse moves over to the corner.

We'll start with the large one.

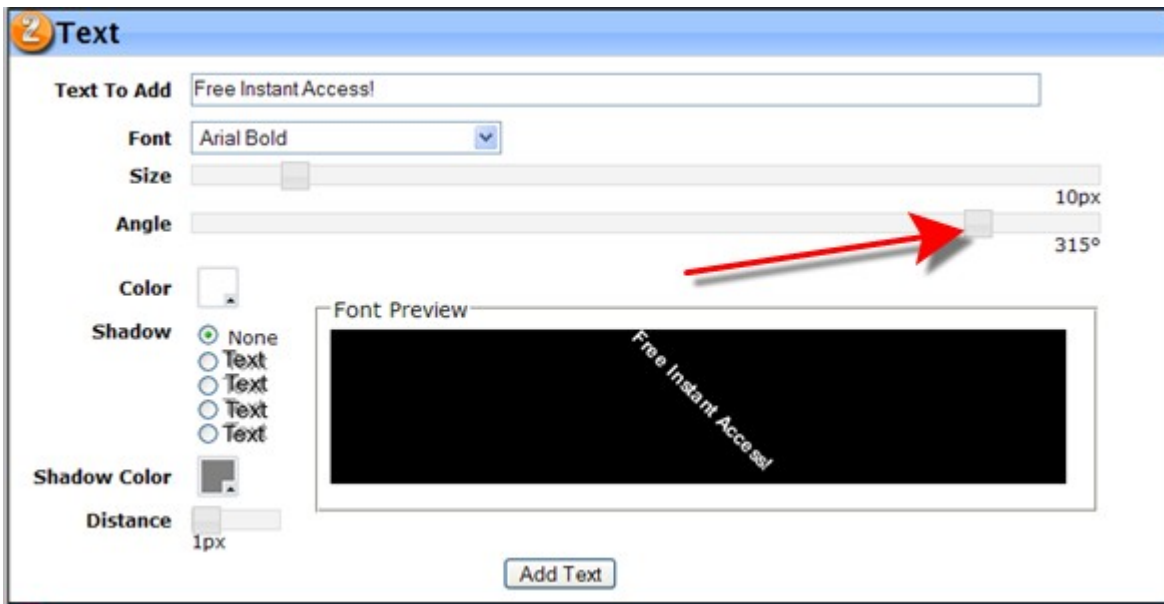


Let's get this first one... by clicking the radio button that says "Use this one" and then click "Use this large peel away ad".

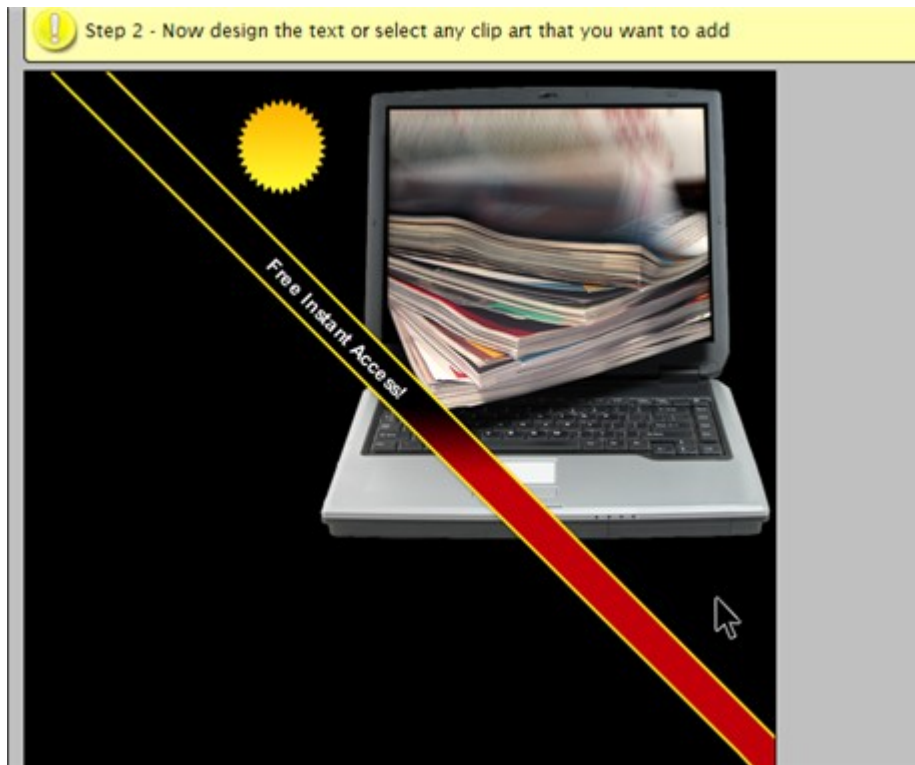


Now, see that diagonal ribbon? We can place text there! The tip of the day is... when formatting the text to fit on those diagonal spaces, choose 315 degrees on the slider bar.. and it will work perfectly!

Like this:



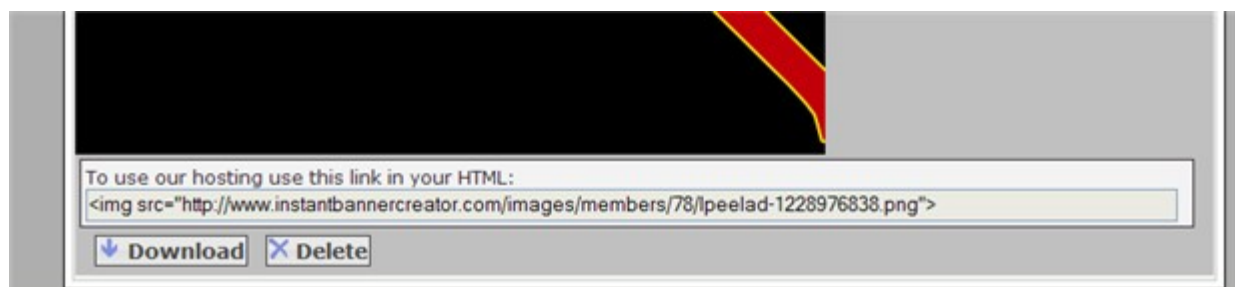
So now, with our Text, the ad will look like this:



And, we want to add something to that big yellow spot.... so we'll use our clipart.



Now, to press "Finish".



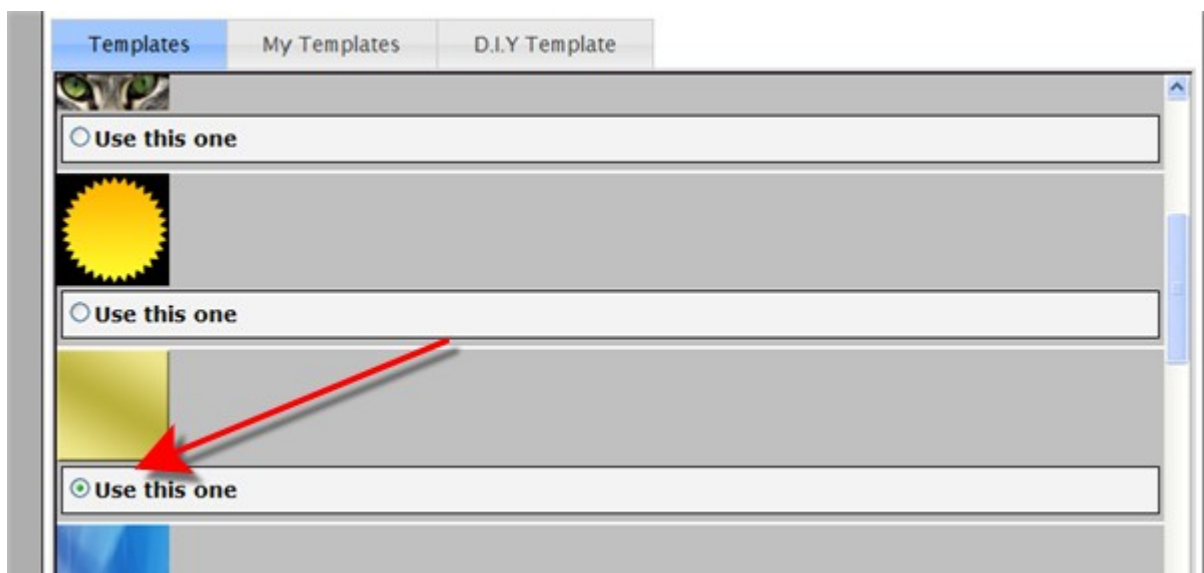
And the URL is provided for you. But.. we need to make the small image.

Once again.. the whole procedure is the same... and we'll go through it again.

Choose "Create a New Small Peel away Ad".

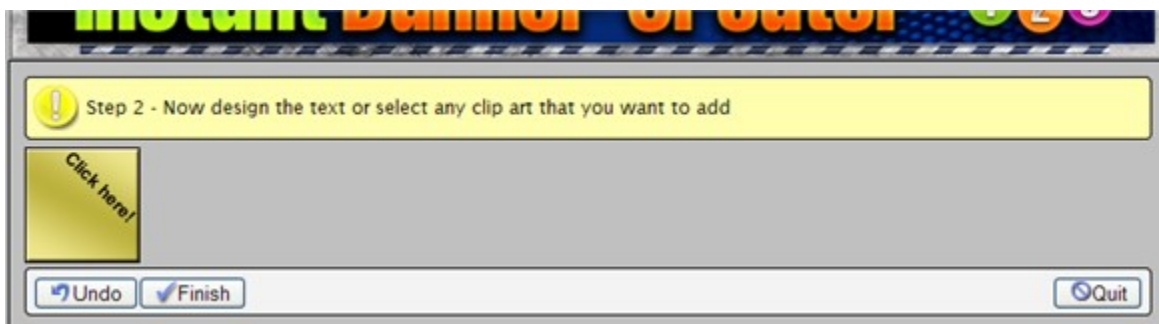
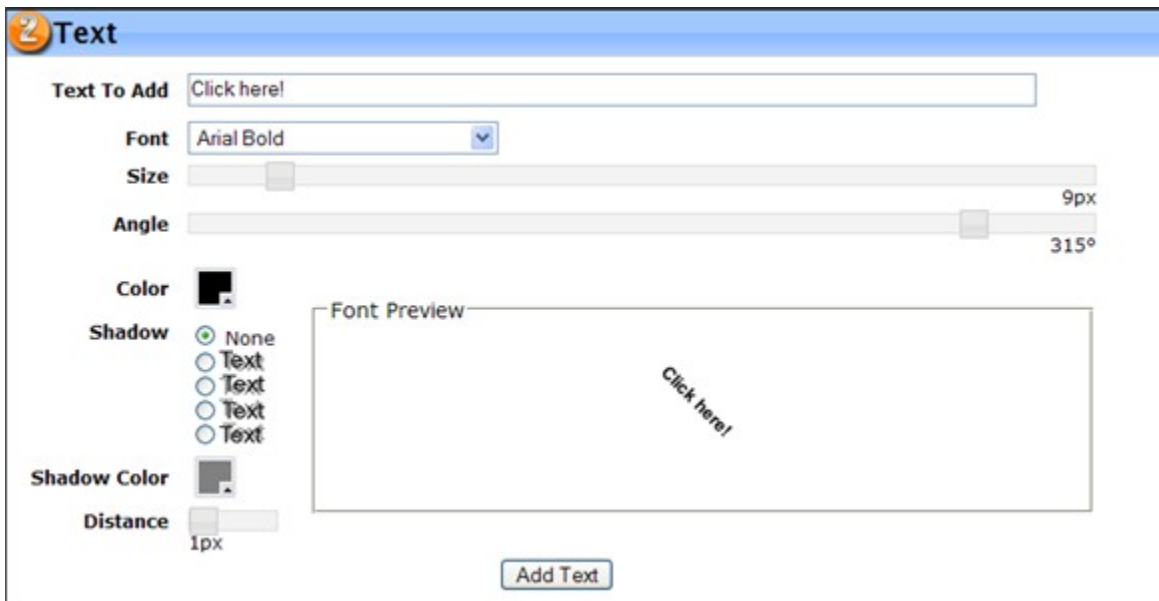


We'll use this yellow square. This is the small part of the peel away ad that catches your eye while viewing the rest of the page. You can leave it blank, or add some text to it.

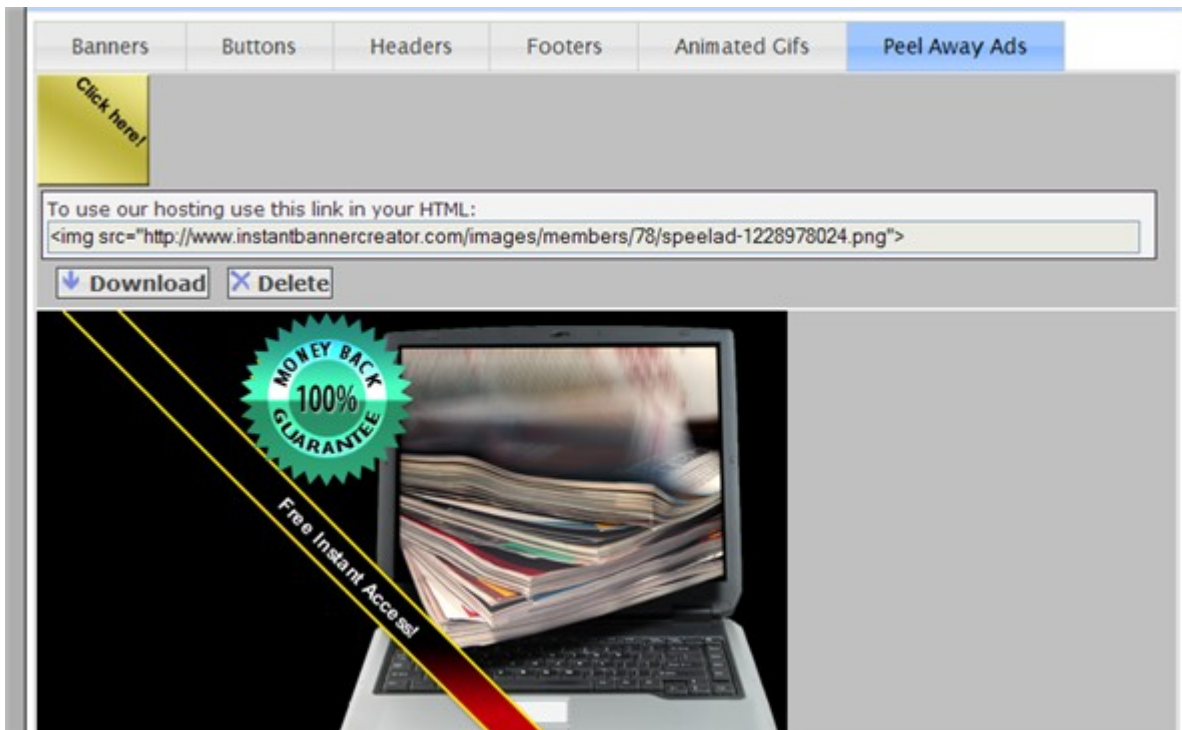


Keep in mind that only part of this image will be seen... the top right half. With that said... that's the only place you want to add any text. We'll add "click here" to this image.

Remember to angle the text at 315 degrees.



Now Click "Finish" and you'll see them in your Saved Graphics area.



Even though Instant Banner Creator will host these graphics for you, you actually need a Peel-away Ad Script in order to show them on your website correctly.

Once you have that, just copy the URLs into the correct places.

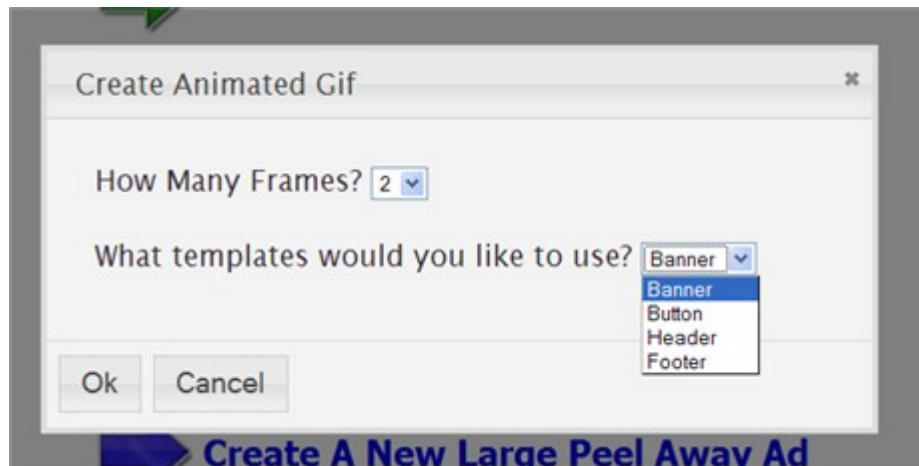

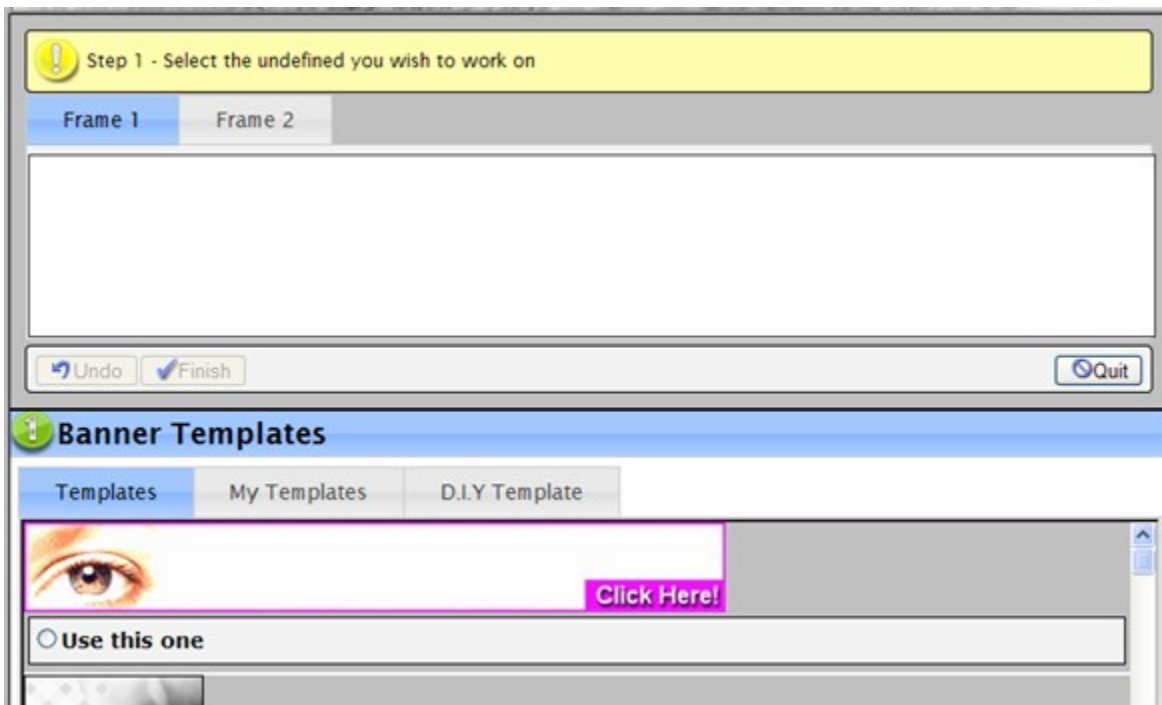
Create A New Large Peel Away Ad



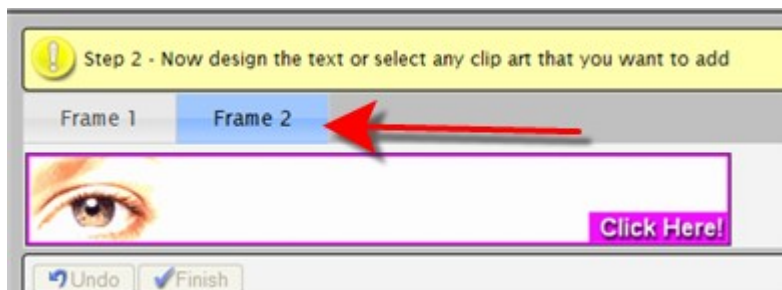
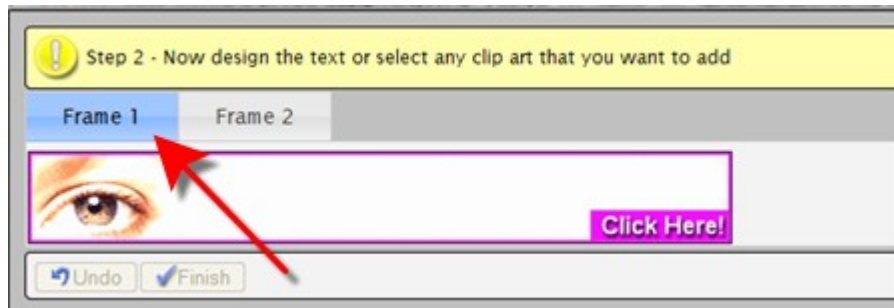
When you click the "Create New Graphic", you'll see this page. Click on "Create a New Animated GIF."



You will immediately see this... asking you about options. As you play with the Animated Graphics, you'll get more of a feel about the whole "How many frames" thing... but we'll choose 2 for now. You can choose between a banner, button, header or footer. We'll choose banner for this example.

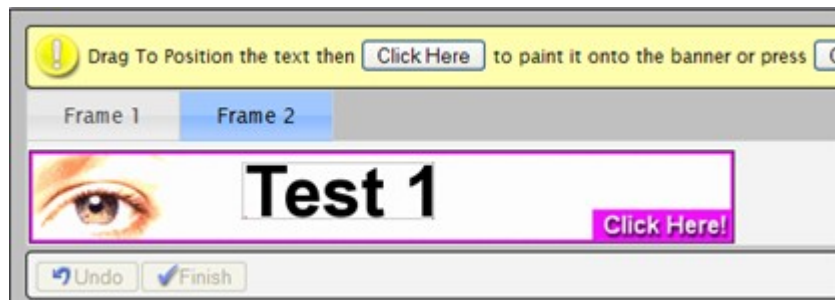


Now, this looks almost the same as the module that lets you create a regular banner, with one big difference. "Frame 1" and "Frame 2" are in tabs at the top of the screen. Let's choose the first template there... and you'll see it's added to both frames.

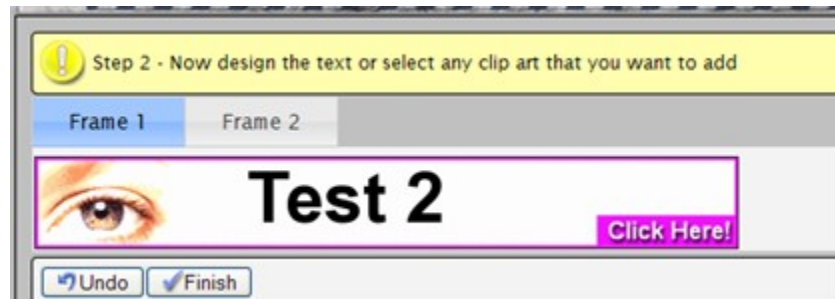


Now we can add some text.

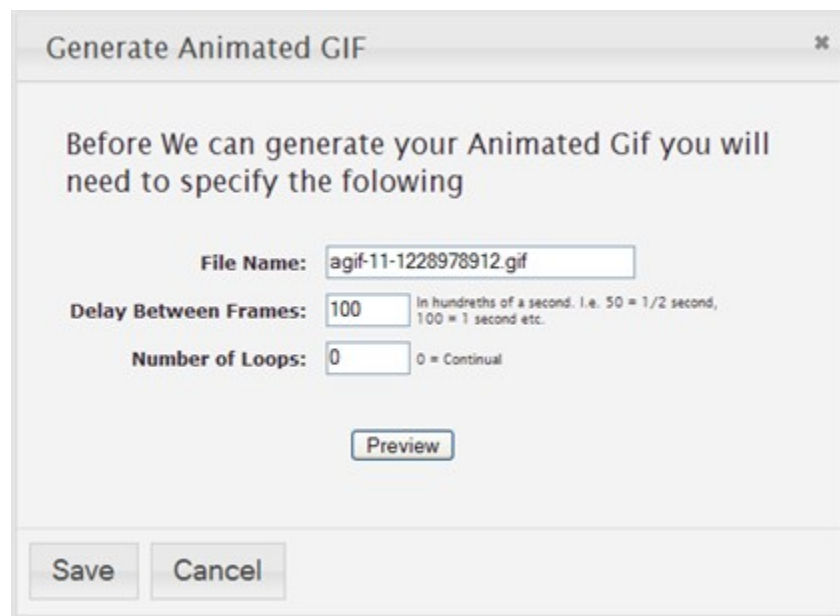
Here's what I've put in the 2nd frame...



And I'll put "Test 2" in the first frame, in the same area.



Now, to save it, click "Finish"...



This window will pop up... where you can change some more settings. "Delay between Frames" is how long before it switches to the next picture. 50 is the default, which is 1/2 a second. We'll type in 100.. which is a full second.

Number of Loops – how many times it runs through the animation. 0 means it will never stop. Let's keep that.



Yay! Here's our banner!

I just used the URL I found here:



This part is great fun to play with... and you can make banners, buttons, headers and footers.. all the same way!

Free members... now if you're just dying to get your hands on this, run to the "Upgrade" tab, and upgrade now!
